This year is the seventh year of the Write To End Violence Against Women Awards and we're excited to see the variety of creative talent that is available in Scotland.

For the first time, this year, we will be accepting submissions and nominations of multimedia pieces as well as written pieces. That means we will be accepting pieces of broadcast, radio, short documentaries, and podcasts.

This year we are accepting submissions and nomination for six separate Award categories:

- Best Piece – News
- Best Piece – Feature
- Best Piece – Opinion and Comment
- Best Piece – Blog and Self Published
- Gender Equality Award: Women and Sport
- Wooden Spoon

To enter this year's Awards all submissions and nominations must:

- Have been published between 01/10/18 and 30/09/19
- Be created in Scotland or primarily reaching a Scottish audience

We're particularly interested in pieces which represent voices not often heard, for example people of colour, LGBT people, disabled people, and people from rural communities and/or working-class backgrounds. We are also accepting submissions in other languages.

Submission for the 2019 Awards will close at midnight on Monday 30 September 2019.
